It is critical for all children to be in attendance at school daily. We do realize that from time to time children do get ill and they should be home. Excusable reasons to keep your child home would be: running a temperature, vomiting, infection that has not been treated with antibiotics for at least 24 hours, funerals, or doctor appointments that cannot be made outside of school time.

You must phone the school at (330) 875-2661 before 9:30 am to report your child off of school. When reporting your child off of school, you may also request for homework to be sent home with another student or you can pick it up in the office from 3:00-3:45. Upon return to school the student must bring a written excuse or doctor's slip for an absence to be considered excused.

DROP OFF & PICK UP









LES school doors open at 8:10 a.m. for students. Parents/quardians will not be permitted to drop off their children before this time. The YMCA offers a childcare program before school to accommodate children as early as 6:30 a.m. in the LES school cafeteria. The program has tiered pricing and is certified for subsidized assistance. If interested, contact them at 330.875.1611.

North Nim doors also open at 8:10 a.m. Students can be dropped off starting at that time. Please do not drop off students prior to this time. Once students are in the building, they will report straight to their homeroom. Breakfast will be available (and is free for all students) in each classroom. Students will eat breakfast in their homeroom class. The school day will begin at 8:30 a.m. It is crucial that all students are in their classrooms by this time for morning announcements. If your child arrives after 8:30 a.m., you must bring him or her in to sign in.

At the conclusion of the day, car riders will be called down to the cafeteria at approximately 3:05 p.m. If your child is a car rider, it is CRITICAL that the adult picking up your child have his or her name on the emergency medical form. A child WILL NOT be released to anyone whose name is not on that list. We ask that whoever is picking up a child bring his or her driver's license in every day. He or she will need to show his or her license to the staff members in the cafeteria. A staff member may get to know him or her and may not always need to see the license, but there will be times throughout the year when that adult may be different, so it is critical that he or she has a license each time. We ask that all car riders be picked up by 3:15 p.m.
